The LAGLOBE (Master- Latin America and Europe studies in Global World) is an multidisciplinary and international programme that lasts 2 years (4 semesters) with a total of 120 credits. Courses are taught in three different universities and in three different languages: English, French and Spanish.

The main goal of LAGLOBE is to study the challenges and relationships between Europe and Latin America as part of a global world, and from a social and humanities perspective, taking into account the theoretical frameworks and values of the European Union and its members countries, as well as its interests in the studied region.
