ABOUT THE MASTER

The LAGLOBE Master (Latin America and Europe in a Global World) is an international and multidisciplinary programme developed by the Universidad de Salamanca, Stockholms Universitet and Université Sorbonne Nouvelle and financed by the European Union's Erasmus + Program

This *Erasmus Mundus* Joint Master Degree has a duration of two years (four semesters – 120 ECTS), and it takes place in 3 universities and in 3 languages.

It provides academic and professional opportunities in the field of social sciences, both in Europe and Latin America.

Selection criteria

- An undergraduate degree in social sciences, humanities or legal sciences equivalent to 180 ECTS.
- Cover letter (600 words)
- A letter of recommendation
- Language certificates: English (C1), Spanish (C1) and French (B2)
- CV
- Research project (1800 words)
- Transcript of records

1st Semester

At the Institute of Ibero-America of the University of Salamanca in Spain, specialized in communication, political science, history and cultural studies



2nd Semester

At the Nordic Institute of Latin American Studies (NILAS) of Stockholm University in Sweden, specialized in regional integration, gender, democracy and citizenship, ethnicity and sustainable development.



3rd Semester

At the Institute of Higher Studies of Latin America (IHEAL) of the Sorbonne Nouvelle University in Paris, specialized in anthropology, geography, economy, political science, sociology and history.



4th Semester

Semester dedicated to the writing of a final thesis and to the election of a specialization :

Fieldwork : 3 months of an empirical work with one of our associated universities in Latin America or Belgium.

Professional internship : 3 months of an internship with one of partners from the professional world in Latin America or Europe.
